New Resources for Struggling Homeowners!

Ohio homeowners may begin submitting applications for financial assistance to prevent default or foreclosure online at www.savethedream.ohio.gov or by phoning toll-free at **1-800-464-4764**. For faster service, the OHFA (Ohio Housing Finance Agency) encourages homeowners to visit the website to begin the registration process so their information can be immediately forwarded to one of the specialized housing counselors in their local area. All applicants will be referred to one of the agencies who will then work with them to help them qualify for the over \$300 million available for Rescue Payment Assistance, Partial Mortgage Payment Assistance, Modification Assistance, and Transition Assistance, from OHFA **Restoring Stability Program**.

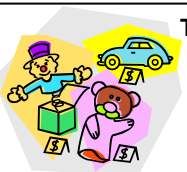
