What Parents Need to Bring:

You **must** bring your picture ID (driver's license, green card, passport, or State ID) and confirmation that you live in the ←**City of Columbus** in one of the zipcodes listed to the left (utility or phone bill in your name). You will also need a Birth Certificate for every child age 14 and under for whom you are applying for gifts. Please keep in mind that **there is no childcare provided during the application process**, so if you must bring your children with you, you will want to bring something to keep them occupied while you and they wait.
