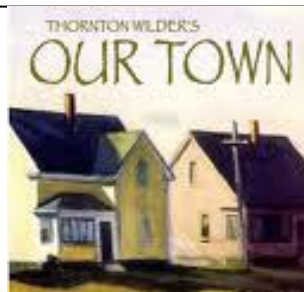

PERTUSSIS (AKA Whooping Cough) Is Making A Big Comeback In Our Community – But It Is Preventable!



Pertussis usually starts with cold-like symptoms, and may be mild cough, but not every runny nose is pertussis. Pertussis is often not suspected or diagnosed until a persistent cough with spasms, characterized by the whooping sound, sets in after 1-2 weeks.

The best way to prevent pertussis is through vaccinations. The childhood vaccine is called DTaP. The pertussis booster vaccine for adolescents and adults is called Tdap. Both protect against pertussis, tetanus, and diphtheria. Call Pat at **724-0107** for info or to schedule a vacc.

A Reminder from the Ohio Dept. of Health: Child Passenger Safety Laws

Ohio Law now requires every child under 8 years old to ride in a child safety seat, unless that child is 4'9" tall or taller. Child safety seats include infant seats, convertible seats, forward-facing seats, booster seats, or other federally-approved devices.
