Two Items This Week: First, two men driving a dark SUV with red and blue flashing lights and claiming to be plainclothes police officers, pulled over a woman at E. Livingston and Brice for an alleged traffic violation. They asked her to step out of the car, then robbed her. If you are stopped by an unmarked vehicle, call **645-4545** to verify the officers' identity before you open your car door. A legitimate officer will not be offended by your checking his or her identity. Second, in the E. Broad and Waggoner area, a silver Chevy with heavily tinted windows, oversized wheels/rims, and the word "MACK" on the trunk, has been seen, possibly casing the neighborhoods. If you see it, please call **645-4545**, especially if you are able to get the license number -- but do not put yourself in danger to do so. Thanks, and stay safe!
